Chanditala (Hooghly): A day after Trinamool Congress MP Abhishek Banerjee was attacked in West Bengal's Sonapur area, the party's chief whip in the Lok Sabha, Kalyan Banerjee, alleged that he suffered a head injury following an assault in his own constituency in Hooghly district on Sunday. Kalyan was walking towards Chanditala police station to submit a memorandum protesting the assault on Abhishek when a group of people waved black flags and called him a "thief". The MP claimed he was struck by a projectile, causing the head injury. Holding a cloth to the back of his head, he fell on the road and later staged a dharna outside the police station, accusing police of inaction. "Suddenly, 10-15 goons shouted slogans. They abused me, but I kept proceeding, and at that time, a stone was thrown at my head. There was blood in my kurta and pajama. All this happened in

front of Bengal police. I had fallen on the road, and that time, a CRPF person came and rescued me," the MP told reporters.

Former CM and Trinamool Congress chief Mamata Banerjee accused BJP of "murdering democracy", alleging that the saffron party orchestrated the attacks on Kalyan and her nephew Abhishek. "Yesterday, BJP supporters brutally attacked Trinamool Lok Sabha floor leader Abhishek Banerjee. The terrifying videos are in the public domain. Today, our chief whip in Lok Sabha, Kalyan Banerjee, was also a victim of a planned BJP attack," Mamata wrote on X.

Hooghly police registered a case against 10 to 15 unidentified persons for voluntarily causing grievous hurt, attempt to murder and intentional insult. A senior police officer, meanwhile, said the preliminary findings did not match Kalyan's account. BJP supporters present at the Chanditala spot, however, rubbished the allegation of a planned assault, calling it a spontaneous expression of public anger against TMC functionaries.

Abhishek also took to his social media account. "This is the reality of today's BJP. If you support them, you are a patriot. If you question them, you become a target."

TMC ex-MLA held in UP for 2021 violence

Prayagraj: Former Trinamool Congress MLA Khokan Das was arrested Sunday near a toll plaza in UP's Prayagraj in connection with Bengal's post-poll violence of 2021, reports Kapil Dixit.

The ex-MLA from Bardhaman is accused of inciting a mob to target BJP functionaries and orchestrating attacks on their homes following the 2021 assembly elections in which TMC had swept back to office.

Police sources said Das's movements were being tracked, and a joint team of Bengal and UP police intercepted him near the Handia toll plaza as he was returning to Bardhaman. Prayagraj DCP Kuldeep Singh said Das would be produced in a local court for transit remand and taken to Bengal. Das, who won the Bardhaman South seat in the 2021 elections, securing 91,015 votes, lost to BJP's Moumita Biswas Mishra by a margin of more than 30,000 votes in the recent polls.



Slain TMC worker's parents flee in fear

Kolkata: Fear of reprisals has driven the elderly parents of deceased TMC worker Sanju Karmakar out of their home in Sonarpur on Kolkata's southeastern fringe after a mob attacked party MP Abhishek Banerjee during a visit to the family home on Saturday.

Karmakar's parents, who had been living alone since the death of their 40-year-old unmarried son, were moved from their home in Sonarpur to their married daughter's residence in Kalikapur, off Kolkata's busy EM Bypass corridor, late Saturday night. Relocation came shortly after security forces escorted Banerjee from Karmakar's house following the attack.

Karmakar's sister Sangita Pramanik said the area remained charged and intimidating, leaving her parents vulnerable to attack. "When the party's national general secretary gets assaulted and local councillors and TMC workers are living in fear, we are

insignificant. How can I leave my parents there without any assurance of security?" she said, urging the authorities to provide protection.

Banerjee said Karmakar was assaulted a day after the May 4 election results, suffered for several days and was later hospitalised, where he died. He advised the parents to move elsewhere temporarily. Sangita said her brother was attacked on May 5, a day after BJP ended TMC's 15-year stint in govt. She said few locals were willing to accompany him to hospital because of fear.

TMC alleged Karmakar was a victim of post-poll violence carried out by BJP-backed assailants. BJP functionaries and some residents, however, said Karmakar died from a medical emergency, possibly a brain stroke, and his family never filed a complaint linking the death to political violence.

Some residents linked his death to possible drug use or a property-related dispute. The family and TMC dismissed those claims.

20-hr rescue op ends in agony: 6 die in Delhi building collapse

New Delhi: Six people were killed and at least 10 wounded but rescued from the rubble of a multi-storey commercial building that "pancake-collapsed" in the densely populated Saidulajab area in south Delhi Saturday evening.

The upper floors of the five-storey building crashed onto the lower ones, causing massive slabs of concrete to land on a neighbouring canteen that was the go-to hangout for students of the locality's coaching centres.

Those killed were the mess owner, Parvati, and three engineers (Kapil, Nalin Rai and Alok Verma) and two doctors (Ravi Verma and Ekta) who were eating dinner there.

A multi-agency rescue operation, spanning 20 hours, concluded Sunday after

noon when the final body was retrieved from the base of the wreckage. Rescue teams deployed specialised victim-location cameras and acoustic listening devices to detect faint signs of life under the concrete blocks. Earthmovers, hydraulic cutters, drilling machines, and trained canine squads were deployed as well.

Delhi Police has filed an FIR on charges of culpable homicide against the absconding building owner, Karmaveer, who is a businessman, and two contractors. Two MCD engineers have been suspended and a magisterial inquiry is underway. 3D mapping of the building is likely to be conducted on Monday.

The building housed offices and co-working spaces. It originally comprised a ground floor and three upper floors, but two additional floors had been constructed over the past few months.

List of vehicles exempted from NH toll may soon be pruned

New Delhi: Govt is looking at pruning the list of vehicles exempted from paying toll on national highways, and the first category that may be removed is "secretaries to govt of India", reports Dipak Dash.

Currently, vehicles transporting and accompanying people holding any of the 25 public offices — such as President, PM, governor, CJI, CMs and MPs — are exempted from paying toll.

Vehicles used for official purposes by defence per-

sonnel, central and state armed forces in uniform, including paramilitary forces, executive magistrate, fire-fighting department, and those on inspection of highway projects and for emergency purposes (ambulance, funeral van) are also exempted from paying toll. TOI has learnt that a high-level committee set up by central govt has recommended the road transport ministry to amend the National Highways Fee Rules by "eliminating the exempted category".

Govt braces for a tough sowing season ahead

New Delhi: Staring at a tough sowing season due to forecast of a weak monsoon and pressure on inputs such as fertilisers and diesel, the Centre will on Monday launch a month-long nationwide campaign on balanced and judicious use of inputs such as fertilisers and water, timely advice to farmers in view of weather-related challenges and delivering benefits of various farm-related schemes directly to villages.

The aim of the campaign — Khet Bachao Abhiyan — is also to motivate farmers to increase the use of green manure, organic and bio products and opt for precision irrigation for optimum use of water.

Ahead of the launch of the campaign from Ramsiya village in Madhya Pradesh's Raisen district, agriculture minister Shweta Singh Chouhan on Sunday said that awareness and practical interventions had become essential keeping in view rising temperatures, indiscriminate and imbalanced use of chemical fertilisers and pesticides, the deterioration of soil health, and growing challenges of the climate crisis.

"Constructive suggestions will be given on dos and don'ts, correct crop options, crop diversification and farming in case of water scarcity or risk," he said.

"The purpose of the campaign will not be just to deliver a message, but to give right advice to farmers at the farm level as per the situation," the minister said.

In view of the forecast of a weak monsoon amid the rising risk of El Nino, the agriculture ministry has already asked states to take measures such as the promotion of drought-tolerant crop varieties, weather-based agro-advisory services, efficient water management and location-specific adaptation strategies to minimise agricultural losses.

Urging the states to brace for the challenging weather conditions, Chouhan, who will visit villages in different parts of the co-

untry during the campaign and interact with farmers, spoke to chief ministers and other stakeholders, including farm scientists, to seek their participation in the initiative.

Chouhan also emphasised that the campaign should be given a multi-dimensional character by ensuring that benefits of schemes such as Kisan Credit Card, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, Crop Insurance Scheme, Soil Health Cards, Mini Seed Kits, Pulses and Oilseeds Mission, and Agricultural Mechanisation programmes reach farmers.

"Constructive suggestions will be given on dos and don'ts, correct crop options, crop diversification and farming in case of water scarcity or risk," he said.

"The purpose of the campaign will not be just to deliver a message, but to give right advice to farmers at the farm level as per the situation," the minister said.

In view of the forecast of a weak monsoon amid the rising risk of El Nino, the agriculture ministry has already asked states to take measures such as the promotion of drought-tolerant crop varieties, weather-based agro-advisory services, efficient water management and location-specific adaptation strategies to minimise agricultural losses.

Urging the states to brace for the challenging weather conditions, Chouhan, who will visit villages in different parts of the co-

untry during the campaign and interact with farmers, spoke to chief ministers and other stakeholders, including farm scientists, to seek their participation in the initiative.

Chouhan also emphasised that the campaign should be given a multi-dimensional character by ensuring that benefits of schemes such as Kisan Credit Card, Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi, Crop Insurance Scheme, Soil Health Cards, Mini Seed Kits, Pulses and Oilseeds Mission, and Agricultural Mechanisation programmes reach farmers.
